The Bufco Corporate Campus was a master planned campus serving the initial development of the Buffco Industries Corporate Office in Longview, Texas. There are an additional 8 sites for other office buildings to be devleoped over several years as lots are sold. This project was to develop a landscape master plan for the main campus entry, shown below, and the office building for Buffco. The theme of the overall project was to be emersed in the forest so very little planting was introduced over most of the site. The entry and the area immediately surrounding the office building were the most intensely planted areas. The entry also incorporates a series of retaining walls that will feature stone to match the building and the wall layers will step back in the land where tree clearings exist to preserve all trees possible.

Vista's responsibility beyond landscape and irrigation were to design the entry drive alignment for the best possible tree preservation scenario, the wall alignment with elevations, the wall design of the materials, The hardscape of teh entry plaza show above, three hardscape courtyards around the building.
